Registration

- Upon arrival, tea/coffee, pastries and granola pots will be available – Wednesday, Thursday & Friday from 8:30am.
- When you arrive, you will be given a name badge, lanyard and programme booklet.
- Please wear your lanyard & name badge at all times.

Ticket changes

- If you are taking the place of someone else, you are required to **inform us before** the event.
- Splitting of tickets is **not** allowed (either in full or part days).
- If you need to amend a 2 or 3 day ticket, contact us before the event.
- For safety & security reasons we need to know who is attending each day.
- We know that sometimes the unavoidable happens and you find you cannot join us last minute. Please **do not** give your ticket to someone else without first contacting and confirming this with us.

Cloakroom

- A cloakroom is available for coats and bags – items are left at owner's risk.
- You cannot leave items overnight.

Accessibility

- Please contact us to discuss any accessibility needs you may have.

Dietary Requirements

- If you have told us about specific dietary requirements, these have been catered for – if you are unsure on anything, please speak to us and/or the venue hospitality team.

Allergens - The venue advises -

Our catering team makes every effort to identify allergens used as deliberate ingredients and to prevent contact contamination throughout food production and preparation. However due to the possible risk of contact contamination in our kitchen and public areas, we cannot guarantee that our dishes do not contain traces of allergens other than those intended.

- We will endeavour to meet our clients and participants dietary requirements.
- Our buffets are labelled to show which dishes are suitable for vegetarian and vegan dietary requirements. Signage is also present stating "If you have a food allergy or a special dietary requirement please inform a member of staff for advice. Thank you". This message is also detailed the menu card for a set menu meal.
- Our service staff are fully briefed on all dietary and allergens contained within the event menu and requirements supplied by the event organiser.
- Participants should be aware that Dynamic Earth is a multi-use venue welcoming hundreds or thousands of visitors to the centre per day. We welcome many different groups of guests on any given day, which will include: School Groups; Family Groups; Events (wide variety of activities & attendees); UK based Tourists/Groups; Overseas Tourists/Groups.
